IABO is sponsoring \$500.00 scholarships for students attending (or planning to attend) the following colleges or universities and majoring in the respective curricula:

- *Des Moines Area Community College Architectural Technologies or Building Trades
- *Inver Hills Community College (MN) Building Inspection Technology
- *Iowa State University Architecture or Construction Engineering
- *lowa Western Community College Architectural Engineering Technology
- *Kirkwood Community College Architectural/Construction Technology
- *Simpson College Pre-Engineering
- *Southeastern Community College Construction Technology
- *University of Northern Iowa Construction Management
- *Western Iowa Technical Community College Design and Drafting Technology

We may also consider other schools or curricula that have similar two or four year programs.
